Attendees at this year's Chelsea Flower Show walked on Flyboo's PlybooEx strand bamboo decking as they admired the silver-metal-winning entry, *Rooftop Workplace of Tomorrow*, designed by the UK-based landscape designer Patricia Fox and built by Giles Landscapes and Aralia Garden Design. Hidden deck fasteners gave the 100 percent bamboo decking a clean finish. Fox chose to use the decking in ebony; it is also available in bronze. ●

Las Vegas Rock's meta-quartzite stone is pure silica bonded with quartz; it's very durable and slip-resistant. The Aria used Split-Face Random Ashlar in the Desert Blend color range. ●
