# Patricia wins award for garden in Allen's Green



HATFIELD Heath based garden designer Patricia Fox has been awarded the Landscape Design Excellence Award by BALI (British Association of Landscape Institute) for a garden in Allen's Green, near Bishop's Stortford.

Pat works for Aralia Garden Design which has been established for four years and has received a RHS Silver Flora award for its courtyard garden at this year's Chelsea Flower Show. Aralia has designed

and built many gardens in the Bishop's Stortford area, and prides itself on the empathy it develops with clients.

Aralia's clients in Allen's Green are thrilled with the news that their garden has been awarded such a prestigious award. Aralia has been working with Karen and Brian Newman for just over two years, a master plan was originally produced and the garden has been completed in stages.

The property is a beautiful 18th century cottage, and the design needed to be very

much in keeping with both the property and the surrounding rural landscape. The garden now includes a large family lawn, reclaimed rustic brick pillars with overhead linear pergola planted with lavender and climbing roses.

A mini-orchard and vegetable garden with willow fencing and a herb garden close to the house.

A living willow igloo provides a fantastic

play den for their son, along with the cleverly bamboo screened trampoline. Oak timbers were used, to match into the internal flooring, for both the entrance archway and rose walk pergola, and two new terraces were created using natural sandstone and oak sleepers.
